The Mary Parminter Charity was started by Jane and Mary Parminter then living at A La Ronde, Exmouth (now owned by the National Trust). In 1811 they completed a building on part of their estate situated in Summer Lane, Exmouth, Devon consisting of a Chapel, School and four

Almshouses, in a 3-acre field overlooking the Exe estuary.

We are a small charity with a board of four trustees (with four vacancies) now responsible for six almshouses and a grade 1 listed chapel set in a 3 acre meadow.

The objects of the charity are to relieve poverty by the provision of housing accommodation with a preference for single women.
